

ADULT FAITHWALK

The Adult FaithWalk program is as varied as the adults in the parish.

Weekly groups:

- On Sunday mornings, between the masses, in the chapel, ***Catechism 101*** meets, as advertised. The offerings are topical and usually for a few weeks at a time. Currently the only program scheduled is the Lenten Offering, Care of Creation.
- On Sunday mornings, between the masses, ***Kitchen Chatter*** meets in the Church hall kitchen. This group primarily discusses contemporary Catholic issues.
- On Tuesday evenings, during the school year, the ***LexBIBLE*** program meets in the library from 6:30pm to 8pm. During the school year 2013-14, we are studying the ACTS OF THE APOSTLES.
- On Thursday mornings after the 9:30am mass, the ***BOOK CLUB*** meets in the library until noon.

Monthly groups:

On the first Monday evening of the month, the ***WOMEN’S SPIRITUALITY GROUP*** meets at the House of Peace from 7pm until.

Small groups:

During Advent and Lent, ***PAX CHRISTI*** recommends that parishioners meet in the small groups in their homes for small group discussion. Prior to Advent and Lent, the parish will recommend one or two programs for use of the small groups.

Library:

PAX CHRISTI has an extensive library of books on philosophy, theology, church history, scripture, and spiritual reading, which are available to be checked out by parishioners.

Catechist formation:

In addition to participating in the diocesan program, the catechists meet regularly throughout the FaithWalk year for in-service training.
