

Entering & Exiting Church — as we return to Mass!

- **Please** put on masks as you leave your vehicle.
- **Enter** only by main doors under the overhang.
- **Please use social distancing** practices (at least 6 feet apart) as people line up outside to get into the church.
- **Doors will be propped open** at appropriate times for entering and exiting.
- **Distribution of masks:** An usher wearing a mask will have the box of masks, and with gloves, hand them out to those who need one. In this way, only one hand per Mass is rummaging through the box. We have masks for adults and children.
- **Hand sanitizer:** At the entrance to church, an usher will have the hand sanitizer and pump a small amount into hands as people enter. They do this on cruise ships before people enter the dining rooms/food lines. This, too, eliminates multiple people touching the hand sanitizer pump and bottle.
- **"If you have flu like symptoms, or feel ill, please do not enter the church."**
- **Signage:** There will be signs throughout church that indicate "Entrance Only" or "Exit Only."
- **As people enter the church,** they need to fill seats from front to back.
- **Couples from the same household** should sit in the chairs of two on the sides of the church. **Families from the same household** should sit up front on the chapel side where four chairs are placed. They can move one or two chairs over if they have five or six members. Families can also sit together in the pews. Individuals should sit on either end of the pew and one in the middle as long as a family is not also sitting in that pew.
- **Leaving Church:** People will leave by sections and rows starting from the back. Ushers will facilitate this for the first couple of week until we get used to it.
- **Leave immediately after Mass** by using the three single doors in front. **Do not exit from the main double doors.**

Please, no gathering in welcome area or parking lot.
